Extension Educator Alicia Criswell told Lions one of the exciting programs is the evGrandPrix program. She said they learned about the program last November and were approved in January with 50% funding. Criswell said a team of high school 4-H members will build an electric go-cart and participate in racing competition as well as business aspects.
