Mike Crull from the Indiana Lions Eye and Tissue Bank spoke before the Centerville Lions Club Monday evening, March 14. Crull showed slides about the eye bank and how an eye is saved for use later and for transplants.

The eye Bank started in 1959 and is located on East 86th St. in Indianapolis. Last year they transplanted 1,835 eye corneas. The bank employs 34 people.
