Monday evening, April 26. Executive Director Wendy Canon said the Center is an outreach of Shepherd's Way Christian Ministries and offers a Christ and Bible centered program for women struggling with alcohol and drug addiction.

Canon said, "History of the program began when Paul Rose began a six-month program for men in 2002 and six years late his wife Karen add the program for women." She added, "Women needed more time to be healed."
