Model T Museum to open in mid-June

Jay Klehfoth of the Model T Ford Club of America told members of the Centerville Lions Club the Model T Museum will open in Richmond sometime in June. Klehfoth and Benny Young of the Museum spoke to the club Monday evening, May 14.

Klehforth said renovation of a pole barn at 309 North 8th Street in Richmond is nearing completion. He said a soft opening will occur in mid-June. He said there will be about 13 vehicles on display, although they have nineteen at the present time. That will allow for a change in the display at different times of the year. Klehforth said the oldest car will be a 1906 Model N Ford, a precurser to the Model T which came out in 1908.



Besides the display of Model T cars, trucks and other types, there will be a library for research purposes and a gift shop. The Model T Ford Museum was previously located at Warm Glow Candles in Centerville. The Model T Ford Motor Club of America has its headquarters in Centerville. Klehfoth is a member of the Centerville Lions Club.
