Kyle Turner talks to Lions about Centerville

Centerville Lions learned about some new things coming to Centerville in the next few months. Kyle Turner talked about Main Street Centerville which is being organized as a non-profit, what's happening at the old elevator site across from Maplewood Park and Dollars for Scholars.



Turner said that Main Street Centerville will help the community in several ways to make it a better place for all. He said Scott and Tina Johnson will be bringing a Farm to Market store at the old elevator site by March 1st. He added the grocery will be a welcome addition to Centerville. Kyle said he and Scott Laster of Frankfort will be building a Five Arch Brewery in the basement of the site.

And he pointed out the importance of the Centerville Dollars for Scholars program, that has averaged \$30,000 annually for scholarships for Centerville High School seniors.

Club President Joe Elstro reported to the group that the Community Halloween Party was a success on October 31, but some adjustments may be needed due to other community events the same evening.
